CADCAM PROTOCOL

The clinic will have two possibly three CEREC machines available for milling crowns.

THERE WILL BE NO ADVERTISING AND NO PROMISING of this PROCEDURE

There will be a 40 count limit per day. There will be a ticket given out to patients for this. These tickets will be given out by the lead in restorative, after evaluation of tooth in restorative. Routing will alert on chart as possible candidate.

Candidates for CEREC include previously endodontically treated posterior teeth with no crown, teeth treated endodontically at the 2 day event, and teeth with no endo with compromised tooth structure.

Patients coming through routing with previous endo or compromised tooth structure. Potential tooth must be evaluated in restorative by restorative lead. Digital image must be taken of possible CEREC tooth candidate. Patient will be given a ticket in restorative after evaluation. Patient will not be promised a CEREC crown until evaluated in restorative and ticket given out.

Patients having endodontic treatment during the two day event: approval for crown will be done after endo is completed and by lead restorative doctor Ticket will be given to proceed to CEREC area

There will be four working chairs in the draped CEREC area.

Approximate time for a single crown prep: 60 minutes

If patient was already prepped for crown: approx 30 minutes

There will be a patient waiting area in front of draped CEREC working area. This area is on the NE side of the working clinic floor.
