Pharmacy Protocol

Please practice universal precautions and follow all standard infection control practices.

Our goal is to relieve pain and address the most urgent need(s).

EMTs are onsite to deal with patient and volunteer emergencies. If you have a patient emergency, stay with the patient, send your assistant or someone near you to alert the department head who will immediately radio for an EMT.

Translators are available. They are in yellow shirts and are readily available.

Please PRINT on the patient charts – DO NOT USE ABBREVIATIONS.

Review the patient health history. If antibiotics or OTC meds are needed, it will be noted in the lower right corner of the patient registration form.

Write the patients name on the prescription and stick the label to the appropriate coin envelope of medication.

Review the instructions with the patient.

Record the patients name and the medication they received on the Medication log.
